Basic Rules:

Dogs must be able to perform all obstacles off leash
Dogs must be under control in and out of the ring.
No harsh corrections will be allowed.
Treats and toys will be allowed in the ring.
Dogs must have at least 6 months of Agility training

The organizing committee may refuse entry for any reason. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the event, regardless of the reason for dismissal. Courses are nested together so that Novice and Advanced will be running together (Advanced followed by Novice at each jump height). Run orders will be posted at the rings and on our website. Standard ring will run tall to small and jumpers ring will run 16, 12, 8, 24, and 20. Everyone will get their first run and then we will start over for second run, then third run. Running will be subject to change in order to make the match run more efficiently.

Run order and more information (including park cancellation due to rain) will be posted on our website the Friday before the Workshop at www.fremontdogtraining.com.

Directions:

From Fremont/San Jose Area:

- I-680 north, exit on CA-84 East towards Livermore (Vallecitos Road)
- Right on Concannon Boulevard (about 7 miles)
- Left on Robertson Park Road (If you hit S. Livermore/Tesla Road you've gone too far)

From I-580 (toward Livermore):

- Take the N. Livermore Avenue Exit towards Downtown Livermore
- Turn right on Concannon Boulevard
- Turn right on Robertson Park Road (the Road sign is a stone marker that is at street level)

You can also take the back road by using Arroyo Road then turning on Robertson Park Road. Please double check your directions on MapQuest or Google Maps.

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability

1. **Assumption of Risk.** The undersigned is aware of the inherent risk of injury, death and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of agility, including without limitation, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment or infectious disease. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from, among other causes the active or passive negligence of Fremont Dog Club or Livermore Area Recreation and Park District, Karen TenEyck and Topnotch Agility. The undersigned is voluntarily engaging in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from participation in dog agility.
2. **Release of Liability.** The undersigned releases Fremont Dog Club and Livermore Area Recreation and Park District, Karen TenEyck and Topnotch Agility from all liability to the undersigned, the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage or demands for personal injury, death or property damage, to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog or dogs, arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitations, any personal injury, death or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of Fremont Dog Club or Livermore Area Recreation and Park District, Karen TenEyck and Topnotch Agility. The undersigned bears sole responsibility for any loss.
3. **Knowing and Voluntary Execution.** The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of Fremont Dog Club and Livermore Area Recreation and Park District negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that Fremont Dog Club, Livermore Area Recreation and Parks District, Karen TenEyck and Topnotch Agility, are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.
4. **I also state my dog(s) is/are not aggressive towards people or other dogs** and that I understand that I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.
